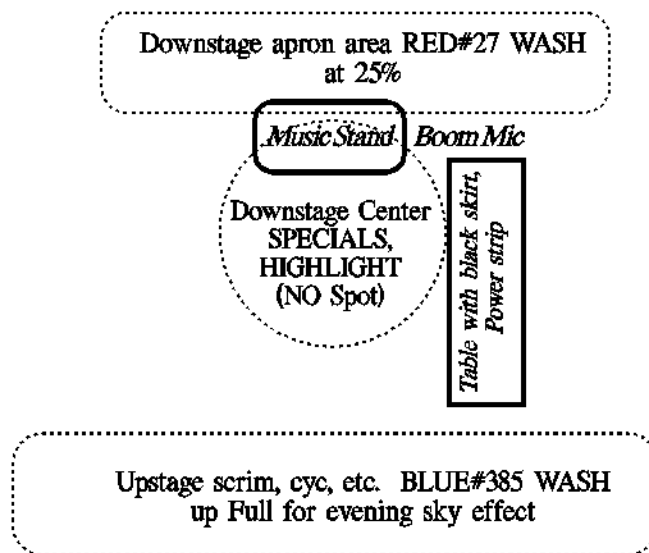

SOUND:

All checks will occur 4 hours before the event. A direct in-line mono effects patch D'ed XLR will connect to the house sound. also:

- 1- 4 foot table with black skirting,
- 1- Shure SM58 on boom stand,
- 1- conditioned 115-120, 60-, VAC source,
- 1- Manhasset music stand, (without rolled lip)
- Gaffer tape, black.

STAGE PLOT:



LIGHTING:

- Downstage apron - red #27 wash @ 25%.
- Upstage cyc/scrim/curtain - dark blue #385 wash only @ 100%.
- Downstage Center specials and highlighter light amber and magenta, @ variable.
- other effects, gobos, etcetera per Light Tech.

DRESSING ROOM:

Lighting, mirrors, restroom, clothes rack with hangers, chairs, proper heating and cooling to maintain 72 degrees fahrenheit, Ice, glasses, and 1 gallon bottled still water, coffee, fresh fruit and nuts.
