Technical Information Sheet - SYMPHONY CONCERT

SOUND: A direct in-line mono XLR patch will connect to the house thru a passive direct box. (see diagram). Mr. Nakai will be seated downstage right of center next to the Conductor's Podium, also he will install his equipment and gaff cables to the music stand.

EQUIPMENT: 1 SM58 on boom stand,
2 Manhasset or Wenger music stands,
1 Chair,
1 115-120VAC power drop,
Gaffer's tape,
Monitors for conductor, soloist and orchestra as necessary.

DRESSING ROOM: Lighting, Mirrors, restroom, clothes rack with hangers, chairs, music stand, heat and cooling control to maintain 72 degrees Fahrenheit, bottled still water and coffee.
