

R. Carlos Nakai

The only American Native Musician to have a platinum record, along with two gold records, eleven Grammy nominations, a Nammy Award, and a Governor's Arts Award

R. Carlos Nakai is widely considered the greatest Native flutist of all time. He is the only Indigenous artist to have reached Platinum status for his album *Canyon Trilogy*. His total sales for his longtime label Canyon Records have reached over 5 million. Nakai performs throughout the United States, Europe, and Japan, with various collaborators including percussionist Will Clipman, guitarist William Eaton, pianist Peter Kater, and multi-instrumentalist AmoChip Dabney. He also appears as a soloist with orchestra and lectures on American Indian topics.

Robert Sims is an acclaimed lyric baritone renowned for his rich, resonant voice and captivating stage presence. Recognized internationally for his artistry, Sims has earned particular praise for his interpretations of African American spirituals and concert repertoire. He has graced prestigious venues such as Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, the Kennedy Center, and major concert halls across Europe, Asia, and North America. Sims has collaborated with prominent orchestras and conductors, as well as a variety of chamber ensembles, always bringing a distinctive warmth and clarity to his performances. Of special note is his ongoing project The Majesty of the Spiritual which he performs in conjunction with some of the most celebrated black vocalists of our time.

In addition to the performance of moving spirituals, the show also includes works by living African American composers complete with a film component highlighting each composer. “Majesty of the Spiritual” reveals the Spiritual as a continually evolving art form, as deeply rooted in the present as it is in the past. “Majesty of the Spiritual” is a testimony in music to the indomitable will that navigated an impossibly tragic, unforgettable past, and a vivid demonstration of musical lineage and poetic tradition, dynamic and powerfully alive today.

The Spicy Pickles includes singer Hannah Rodriguez-who is a four-time Downbeat Award Winner- backed by a 7-piece ensemble. Earning their reputation as a Swing Band that gets everyone up on their feet, the Denver-based Spicy Pickles have broadened their set lists to include elements of jazz, funk, soul, and pop. They draw inspiration from legends like James Brown, T-Bone Walker, and Count Basie. They also embrace contemporary influences such as Sharon Jones & The Dap Kings, Amy Winehouse, and The California Honeydrops. The Spicy Pickles also compose their own original music which has been placed in film and commercials around the world, such as Yorgos Lanthimos' "The Killing of a Sacred Deer." The Spicy Pickles have been touring for over a decade, spreading the "brine" from coast to coast.

Known for their fearless blend of classical precision and boundary-pushing creativity, this powerhouse ensemble seamlessly moves from reimagined pop anthems to bold new commissions, and from jazz-infused grooves to electrifying takes on orchestral favorites. Collaboration fuels their artistry: whether commissioning genre-bending works, partnering with fellow creatives, or engaging communities through dynamic workshops and school programs, Zephyr creates experiences that are as inclusive as they are inspiring. In just the past year, Zephyr has premiered multiple new works, collaborated with award-winning composers, and racked up thousands of new fans through viral performance videos—proving that brass chamber music can be as fresh and current as any genre on stage today.

Mariachi Garibaldi de Jaime Cuéllar has truly become America's Mariachi! First, there were videos with pop sensation Camila Cabello! Next there was a viral "Mariachi Jacket Exchange" with Los Angeles Dodgers relief pitcher Joe Kelly. He later proudly wore it to the White House! Recently the Mariachi have appeared on Netflix's *Dead to Me* and *John Mulaney Presents: Everybody's in L.A.* This group has a 30-year history of delighting audiences at both intimate venues and major theaters. With dancers optional, their program *Soñando con Mexico (Dreaming of Mexico)* tours globally. The Mariachi also collaborate with a "Who's Who" of Mexican artists such as Aida Cuevas, Pedro Fernandez, and Ana Barbara.

Ballet Folklórico del Rio Grande



Ballet Folklórico del Rio Grande (BFRG), under the direction of Miguel Peña, is an eighteen-member organization comprised of alumni of the internationally recognized collegiate folklórico program offered at The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley. UTRGV offers the only folklórico dance major in the United States and produces the wellspring of highly skilled professional dancers that comprise BFRG. With numerous state, national, and international concerts under their belt, they are in demand for concerts and residencies. They often partner with Mariachi Garibaldi de Jaime Cuéllar performing shows celebrating all aspects of Mexican culture, including the Día de Los Muertos and Christmas holidays.




