Caro Pierotto & Grecco Buratto Present *A Thousand Ways Home*

A Brazilian musical journey of love, belonging, family, and the many meanings of home

Brazilian singer-songwriter Caro Pierotto and acclaimed guitarist and vocalist Grecco Buratto bring their deeply personal musical journey to the stage with *A Thousand Ways Home*, an intimate performance celebrating love, connection, Brazilian roots, and the many paths that lead us back to what matters most.

Caro and Grecco grew up just a few miles from each other in southern Brazil, but their paths did not cross until years later in Los Angeles, when Grecco attended one of Caro's shows in Hollywood. What began as a musical connection evolved into a life partnership and a prolific creative collaboration that has resulted in more than 80 songs written, produced, and recorded together.

A Thousand Ways Home draws from their shared experiences as Brazilian artists building lives far from where they began. Through original compositions and Brazilian classics, the duo explores themes of love, family, distance, belonging, and the search for home. Their music blends the warmth of Bossa Nova and Brazilian rhythms with elements of jazz, pop, and contemporary music, creating an intimate atmosphere grounded in storytelling and emotional connection.

Caro's warm, expressive voice and Grecco's tender vocals and exquisite guitar playing create a performance that feels deeply personal and inviting. Their stories reflect the reality of life as international touring artists—being away from family, living between countries, and discovering new ways to remain connected despite the distance.

Grecco Buratto tours internationally as the lead guitarist for Lionel Richie. When he is home, he joins Caro on tour with her all-star Brazilian band, while *A Thousand Ways Home* brings the couple back to their roots as a duo.

More than a concert, ***A Thousand Ways Home*** is an invitation to slow down, listen, remember, and connect—a celebration of the places we come from, the people we love, and the thousand ways we find our way home.

Caro's Bio

Brazilian singer-songwriter Caro Pierotto is one of the leading voices of contemporary Brazilian music in the United States. Originally from Rio Grande do Sul and based in Los Angeles, she has spent over two decades sharing the richness of Brazilian culture with audiences around the world through her captivating voice, joyful stage presence, and original songwriting.

Caro's career spans international stages, film, television, and major collaborations. She worked with acclaimed producer Pharrell Williams on the soundtrack for *Trash*, directed by Academy Award-nominated filmmaker Stephen Daldry. She performed alongside Snatam Kaur at the 2019 Grammy Premiere Ceremony, had her song "É Tão Bom o Nosso Amor" featured in the Apple TV+ series *Servant*, and was selected to perform at the NAMM Show's ADJ Arena Plaza Stage in 2023. She also recorded the duet "A Nossa Volta" with celebrated Brazilian samba artist Rogê, composed by Rogê, and wrote and performed twelve original songs for Facebook Sound Collection.

Her music has reached audiences across Canada, France, the United Kingdom, Colombia, Mexico, Portugal, and Indonesia. Two of her recordings, "Mal Acostumado" and "Mera Ilusão," have been featured on Putumayo compilations, further establishing her place in the global world music community. In 2022, she returned to Rio de Janeiro to record *Sambalismo*, a live studio album celebrating the timeless spirit and evolving sound of Brazilian music.

Whether performing in Portuguese, English, or Spanish, Caro delivers an authentic and uplifting musical experience that blends samba, bossa nova, MPB, forró, and her original compositions. Backed by her exceptional Brazilian band, she invites audiences to sing, dance, and experience the joy, warmth, and soul of Brazil.

Grecco's Bio

Grecco Buratto is an artist, producer, musician and poet. He has toured, recorded and performed with Shakira, Gwen Stefani, BTS and Enrique Iglesias. He has been a member of Lionel Richie's touring band since 2025.

He has written music for tv show *Dawson's Creek*, *Everwood* and *Brothers and Sisters* and has worked with composers Gustavo Santaolalla (*Babel*) and James Newton Howard for movies like *Miami Vice*, *First Daughter*, *RV* and *Woman on Top*.

He has written, produced and recorded with his life-partner, Caro Pierotto, over 70 songs, 4 albums and numerous singles.

His latest album, Sem Palavras was released in 2023 alongside his first book of poetry, Só Palavras on Editora Versiprosa.
